What happened to the manuscript and how did it end up at the British Library? Alice Liddell treasured the manuscript until 1928, but was then forced to sell it to pay death duties after the death of her husband. The manuscript was sold at auction at Sotheby's for £15,000 to an American dealer, Dr Rosenbach.

Alice's Adventures Under Ground ... - The British Library

Alice's Adventures in Wonderland began life as a story Carroll (whose real name was Charles Lutwidge Dodgson) told to his young friend, the 10-year-old Alice Liddell. He subsequently wrote out the tale for her by hand, and called it Alice's Adventures Under Ground. The British Library owns the original manuscript.

Alice's Adventures in Wonderland (commonly shortened to Alice in Wonderland) is an 1865 novel by English author Lewis Carroll (the pseudonym of Charles Dodgson). It is considered to be one of the best examples of the literary nonsense genre.
