The following is a best-practice checklist to help you maintain a safe, secure environment for babies and toddlers in your church. Ensure proper screening of all workers. This is the single most important safety measure you can take. Use a secure check-in system.

Safety Checklist for Your Church Nursery

Nursery workers are to remain in place until feasible to leave the area (as the number of children decreases). A worker must remain until all children are removed from the nursery needs to be in order before you depart the area. Arrive at least 10-15 minutes prior to service or event—earlier if expecting a larger crowd for special services or events. 2. Become familiar with nursery policies and facilities.

A nursery worker should never be alone with a child in a restroom. Have two teachers escort a group of children to the restroom. If a single child needs to go, have the volunteer stand outside with the door propped open.

Nursery Safety: Choose Volunteers Carefully Clearly define what (if any) symptoms a child is allowed to have (such as a runny nose), what symptoms are not allowed (like a fever) and how long the child has to be symptom-free before they can stay in your church nursery. Many daycares require kids to be symptom-free for at least 24 hours.

Teaching Tips for Your Volunteers in the Church Nursery At least one of the workers must be an adult (over the age of 18). The other worker must be age 14 or older. All Nursery workers must complete the paperwork outlined in #9 below. New attenders will not be scheduled until they have attended Grace Bible Church for at least six months.

Typical nursery requirements specify one attendant for every four children, although some states may vary in this requirement based on the ages of the children. Generally "safety-first" rules mandate that there must be at two adults, aged 18 or older, working in the nursery.

The nursery worker must be motivated to serve because of commitment and a desire to minister to His children. • Keep a loving attitude with children. A genuine love for children must dominate the nursery worker's attitudes, thoughts, and actions.
