An ethical dilemma can be defined as a situation where there is only a decision which is "more right' than the alternatives" (Hill, Glaser, & Harden, 2008, p.102). In effect it is a situation where either decision is going to be difficult for the client and practitioner.

### Ethical Dilemmas: Analysis of ethical case scenario
