The Progressive Era itself lost momentum after Theodore Roosevelt left office, another factor which affected the muckrakers. McClure's Magazine was one of the earliest of the muckrakers, and when several of its most noted writers in the genre defected to form The American Magazine its impact was severely blunted.

Lesson 2.01 Origins of the Progressive Era

2. Framing: This is the first lesson in the unit, so it will draw on personal opinion to introduce the Progressive era and push for reform measures to students. 3. Objective(s): I want students to understand that there was no one progressive movement, but a conglomeration of individual movements attempting to remedy problems within society.

Lesson Plan: Reform: Today and Yesterday Subject ...

Students are introduced to muckraking journalism and the reform movement of the Progressive Era. First they focus on prominent muckrakers and reformers. Next, they learn about the Pure Food and Drug Act of 1906 as a prime example of Progressive Era reform that had a lasting impact. Finally, they ponder the topic of investigative journalism itself.
