Bale silage bales are much heavier, if made to their full size, than normal hay bales (typically baled at 16 to 18% moisture), which can make it more difficult for a loader or tractor with a front-end loader to transport from feed yard to corral. The reduced size should make them easier to manage, plus wrap up.

Silage comes out pretty easy with a potato fork. If you need to bump proteins. You can add distillers grains. In layers. Add a couple tbls of molasses to a quart of water to ensure proper bacteria and make it more edible. I use my lawn and leaf/ brush chipper to make it. For the hay silage I use my push mower with bagger.
