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### Standard Risk Register Risk Status

A risk register is a document or system that is used to capture risk management status. They are commonly used to manage strategy, project and operational risks. The following are common elements of a risk register.

#### 11 Elements of a Risk Register - Simplifiable

"Risk Register (or Risk Log) is a document that contains all the results of risk analysis and where risk response plans are recorded." The results of other risk management processes eventually also end up in Risk Register. You fill it in during the planning phase.

#### 8 Example Risk Register Categories, classifying your types ...

The Risk Register is the document containing the results of the qualitative risk analysis, quantitative risk analysis, and risk response planning. The risk register details all identified risks, including description, category, cause, probability of occurring, impact on objectives, proposed responses, owners, and current status. It is a spreadsheet containing all the statements of risk identified for the project.

#### Risk Register - Introduction - Business Projects-IT ...

The Project Manager will use the Daily Log and transfer the risks to the Risk Register later. The Risk Register is created in the Initiation Stage (IP process) by the Project Manager. The Risk Management Approach document will describe how the Risk Register should be configured and used. The Risk Register is updated in the Controlling a Stage process as the Project Manager will examine new risks and check on the status of existing risks.

The risk register is the central repository for all potential risks that could occur at any time, anywhere in the organization. Assess risks and develop risk statements. Assessing risk means identifying and analyzing the threats and vulnerabilities that could adversely affect your organization’s business objectives.

#### Manage risks, risk statements, and risk frameworks

A risk register is a document used as a risk management tool and to fulfill regulatory compliance acting as a repository for all risks identified and includes additional information about each risk, e.g. nature of the risk, reference and owner, mitigation measures. The main purpose of a risk register is to serve as the database for specific risks. These risks might be safety risks, commercial risks, financial risks, environmental risks and more - and you may have specific registers for each type of risk - or consolidate more than one functional risk into a general project management risk register.

Risk Management As standard, P6 includes a risk register. As with the rest of P6, this risk register can be configured to contain the relevant information for a company. Probability, impact type and impact ranges can be defined to reflect the important factors for a specific company.

Status of risk (active, not started, ongoing, complete, dormant, retired) You can include additional components in your risk register as well, such as residual risk, action progress, response effectiveness rating, and threat responses.

At a minimum, your risk register should include a unique identifier for each risk, a description of it, actions to be taken in response, and the owner of the task. The descriptions should be brief and to the point.

#### How to Create a Project Risk Register

3. Risk ID – This is a unique identification number used to identify and track the risk in the risk register. If Resources is Category 8, then the first risk identified in this category has a unique ID of 8.1. Elements 4 to 6 record the results of the Risk Analysis phase.

The Risk Register The Risk Register captures and maintains the information (both threats and opportunities) on all the risks that were identified and relate to the project. So it provides a record of all risks including their status and history.

Components of a Risk Register There is no standard list of components that should be included in the risk register. The Project Management Institute Body of Knowledge (PMBOK) and PRINCE2 among other organizations make recommendations for risk register contents, but they are not set in stone.
