In 1802, James T. Callender published an editorial in the Richmond Recorder that claimed President Thomas Jefferson had fathered a child with Sally Hemings, one of his own slaves. The story gained traction in the Federalist press (Jefferson was a Republican), but Jefferson ignored the allegation and never commented on it.

### Sally Hemings and Thomas Jefferson: Myths and Facts - History

Sally Hemings was a woman enslaved by Thomas Jefferson, inherited through his wife Martha Wayles Skelton Jefferson (October 19/30, 1748–September 6, 1782) when her father died. Sally's mother, Betty, was said to be the daughter of an enslaved African woman and a White ship captain; Betty's own children were said to have been fathered by her owner, John Wayles, making Sally a half-sister of Jefferson's wife.

Sally Hemings returned with Jefferson and his daughters to Monticello in 1789. There she performed the duties of an enslaved household servant and lady's maid (Jefferson still referred to her as "Maria's maid" in 1799). Sally Hemings had at least six children fathered by Thomas Jefferson. Four survived to adulthood.
